2-Benefits of general health

- Build physical strength .
- Resistance to infections

honey

control of acarians

Tonic for strong colonies

Add 3-4 drops of lemongrass and 3-4 drops of spearmint essential oils to 1 kg sugar :1litre water syrup.

3 Botanicals for varroa (acaricides)





Essential oil application

- Add 5-6 drops of thyme or lavender essential oil to 200ml of mineral oil
- Bee calm spray page 4
- Apiguard
- Precautions with essential oils
- Add a couple of fresh or dried mugwort leaves to fondant or syrup feed

Bee Calm spray

- 'Just dig it farms', USA use this instead of smoking the bees
- used for inspection, uniting, new frames, harvesting, new queen
- Does not taint honey
- Blocks pores of varroa shutting down nervous system
- Spray bees and inside hives walls. Do not over spray as left overs can go mouldy.

Syrup 250ml sugar:250ml water 500ml water : 16 drops essential oils. Whisk water and 16 drops of your oil mix to emulsify it, it goes milky. Cool syrup and add to spray bottle with emulsified water / oils mix. Shake before use.

Wintergreen photo

- Lemongrass- smells like queen-calms, attracts bees
- Spearmint- miticide; anti fungal, insecticide optional substitutes
- Thyme- use smaller quantity, very strong antibacterial,fungal,miticide,insecticide
- Wintergreen- antifungal;miticide;deters robbing insects,hive beetle, foul brood
- Ti Tree- anti bacterial & fungal, insecticide, varroa
- Lavender- anti bacterial, calming, insecticide

- Chaparelle /Creosote bush (Larrea tridentata) ref
- Tansy (Tanacetum vulgare), ,
- Methods of applications-



6 Smoking methods

Smoking method 1

I use a little tansy or chaperelle smoke or icing sugar on most inspections. I haven't noticed any unpleasant taint. Both herbs are very bitter..



Smoking method 2

To minimise use of chaperelle while staying effective.

Remove queen for 10 days, so no eggs. Return queen

Wait 7 more days. On day 8 after queen is released, smoke with Chaparelle/ Creosote bush every day for 7 days. This exposes all mites to the smoke; ref Top bar Bee keeping, Les Crowder & Heather Harrell.

7 No foundation hives

Bees build varying sized comb to fit the different sized brood.
 This allows less room for the varroa.

9 Other natural controls of varroa-Ants and icing sugar

Biological control

Formic Aid treatment or allowing ants to live with the bees?

 Pseudoscorpions (chelifer cancroides, Ellingsenius fulleri / indicus.) feed on mites. Historically co habited bee hives.

Easy to breed at 18C, harmless to humans.

Sugar dusting

hairdresser's powder puffer; ref; to puff icing sugar over the bees. Use instead of smoke to calm the bees; remove mites; to get the bees in the habit of cleaning each other.

Mesh over the bars method to apply icing sugar.

Make your own icing sugar due to corn starch.

Mineral oil Bee gym___

10 Control of tracheal mites

Menthol crystals

Start to melt at 70F/21C

Best 80-85F/30C. If this hot when no honey flow put menthol crystals in 200mm x 200mm porous bag and leave over frames



 In cooler climates make menthol fondant 1kg granulated sugar 500g vegetable shortening, 3g menthol crystals. Use before or after honey flow.

Menthol disturbs tracheal mite's lifecycle as females can't find /smell the young bees to lay eggs on.ref.Clemson bee education

 Caution- use cautiously as it stops the bees being able to smell the queen. 11 Natural products smoke and its effect on Acarapis woodi and honey bees

- Abstract We tested the effect natural products smoke has on the honey bee tracheal mite
 (Acarapis woodi)and honey bees. Plant materials screened for activity included coffee beans
 (Coffea arabica), corncobs (Zeamays),chaparelle/ creosote bush (Larrea tridentata), eucalyptus
 (Eucalyptus sp.), orange peel (Citrus sinensis), pecan leaves (Carya illinoiensis), dead and
 fresh pine needles (Pinus cembroides), mesquite leaves (Prosopisglandulosa) and tobacco
 (Nicotiana tabacum) and un treated control. Low but significant mite mortality was caused
 by the smoke of pine needles, mesquite, corncobs, and coffee beans.
- Bee mortality at 18 and 5 days after 6 minutes smoking is high with corncobs.
- Pecan and mesquite leaf smoke caused regurgitation and anaesthesia.

12. L. tridentata (Chaparelle /creosote bush)


- The smoke of Chaparrelle / L. tridentata killed more adult A. woodi than other materials in the study. It was not effective against immatures.
- Efficacy was modest (ca. 70%) and it caused transitory bee anaesthesia. The study does not recommend using this material as a mite control
- Older leaves or whole plant are more effective killing adult male tracheal mites than young leaves.
- Smoke time ideal is 6 minutes
- Second treatment is not needed
- My Conclusion

Use Menthol crystals, 1 week; Thymol /Apiguard 2 weeks and Chaparelle smoking once during week 4.

14 Other essential oil uses

- Lemongrass- swarm lure sprinkle a few drops on frames with some honey in bait hive.
- Cinnamon sprinkle a few drops on exterior of hive and around ground and legs/stand to deter insects and ants.
- Peppermint sprinkle a few drops on bee suit to deters bees
- lavender- sprinkle a few drops on bee suit to deters bees
- Insect repellent with these oils covers human/ testosterone smell which encourages bees to sting. Use on bee suit around armpits.
- BUG SPRAY from Backyard Beekeeping USA. In to 200Ml distilled water/ witch hazel add some or all of these oils. Up to 100 drops of essential oils (8ml).Citronella,Myrtle(sweet),Lavender, Ti Tree, Lemon grass, Peppermint, Rosemary. Shake before use, or whizz to emulsify.
- Helpful herbs' mix has cedarwood and eucalyptus as well as citronella, tea tree, lavender and myrtle.
